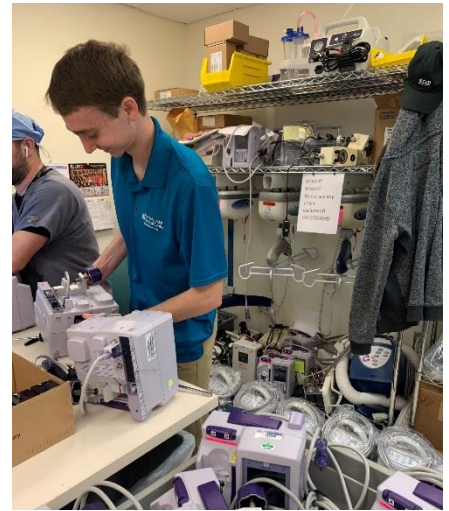


Student Volunteers at AAMC

Applications are accepted for the fall, spring and summer semesters.

► Opportunities

- > Positions available in clinical environments including Biomedical Engineering, Blood Draw Lab, Oncology Infusion, Emergency & Pediatric Emergency Departments, Interventional Radiology, Labor & Delivery, Patient Transport, Physical & Occupational Therapy, and more.
- > Non-clinical environments including the Hospital Gift Shops, Out of the Box Resale Shop & the Doordan Institute (Conference Center).

► Qualifications

- > Must be at least 16 years old and entering 11th grade by semester start date
- > Able to commit to at least a three-hour shift per week of volunteering in an assigned placement for the entire semester
- > Friendly, compassionate, attentive and willing to learn
- > Must provide an unofficial transcript
- > High school students must provide two letters of recommendation.
- > Must meet AAMC immunization requirements
- > AAMC has a tobacco free policy.

► Other Details

- > Student volunteers will attend a mandatory hospital orientation and will learn about AAMC culture, policies, procedures, and the expectations of the volunteer program.
- > Student volunteers must purchase a uniform shirt for \$10.
- > The fall semester runs September 3rd or October 1st through December 18th.
- > **Fall semester applications are due by August 1st (for September start date) and September 1st (for October start date).**
